Solio Ranch is home to a diverse range of animals, including the Big Five (lion, leopard, elephant, buffalo, and rhino). During the game drive, your guide will share interesting facts and insights about the flora and fauna of the region. The park is known for its successful rhino conservation program, and there is a good chance you'll spot both black and white rhinos during the day. Later, embark on a scenic 1-hour drive towards Lake Naivasha, one of Kenya's most famous freshwater lakes, located in the Great Rift Valley. Upon arrival at Lake Naivasha, Board a boat and embark on a serene boat safari around the lake, known for its rich birdlife, including pelicans, cormorants, and various species of herons. - There are very few toilets during game drives at designated locations within the parks.
- Electricity in the camps is provided by a generator and may not be available 24 hours a day.

- Most of the accommodations within the parks have no air-conditioning.
- Some of our tours require walking or stairs between tents.
