On arrival, we proceed for a guided city tour of Tallinn: See the Toompea Hill, Parliament building, Dome Church, St. Nicholas Church, Town Hall Square. Next, we see the Alexander Nevsky Cathedral. Later, we drive to the pier to take the ferry back to Helsinki. Overnight in Helsinki, Finland. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Next, Visit Fazer experience centre and learn the art of chocolate making including chocolate tasting. Later, we board the cruise across the Baltic Sea to Stockholm. Overnight on board Silja / Viking. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Also, we visit the Stockholm City Hall - the seat of Stockholm Municipality. Next, we visit Vasa Museum - Sweden's most visited museum enshrining the warship, Vasa, this outstanding museum, which houses eight exhibitions, is one of Sweden's most popular tourist attractions because of its beautifully preserved wooden warship that sank in Stockholm Harbour during her ill-fated maiden voyage in 1628. Go up on the gondola to the SkyView –Stockholm's landmark, a world-class attraction that takes you to the top of the world's largest spherical building for a fantastic view of Stockholm. In the evening we spend some free time in Gamla Stan – the old Town. Overnight in Stockholm, Sweden. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)
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DAY 5	Onto Oslo -the capital of Norway. Visit Karlstad – beautiful lakeside town in Sweden. We wander around the idyllic countryside, before embarking on a boat ride through the Aurlandsfjord into the Naeroyfjord, one of the narrowest fjords in Europe, surrounded by mountains of up to 1800 meters. On arrival at scenic Gudvangen, we board the coach and travel through the impressive Norwegian landscape to Bergen. Overnight in Bergen, Norway (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)
